Board Meeting – August 10, 2017

Minutes

Present: Joanne D, Jim S., Doug K., Jessica S., Roger B., Jack B., Libby Q., Allison H.

Meeting:

President Snook called the meeting to order at 7:30

Consent Agenda including:

- Minutes of previous meeting
- Treasurers Report
- Attendance Report
- Membership Report

Discussion: Yvonne A. listed as honorary member. Roger Black can't recall how that happened. Roger will switch her to a 3-mos. Leave of Absence.

Consent Agenda approval motioned by Joanne D., Seconded by Jack B. and approved by the board.

Board Discussion:

Ad Hoc "New Vision" Committee — Joanne D. put forward that the chair of this committee should not be a current or previous president. Joanne is looking for some guidance from the District, possibly Bonnie Black, DG Sue Bellor or AG Martha Weaver, at the first meeting of the committee.

Committee Leadership — Concern was expressed by several board members about an apparent lack of enthusiasm or commitment on the committee level in some cases. Roger B said he is now asking committee chairs to make committee reports to the club membership at assembly meeting dates that he assigns. The reports are primarily oral reports but a few sentences in writing are also being asked for. The same is being asked for following major club-sponsored events.

Winter Carnival — Allison H-B reports that she will be stepping down as the Winter Carnival Chair. She and her co-chair, Joan Sterling, have become very discouraged that the last two Winter Carnival events have cancelled due to weather conditions. Allison feels a new concept is needed that isn't so weather dependent.

Rotary Radio Day — There are some members who feel that the club would be premature to abandon the Rotary Radio Day at this time. Even though member participation is low in terms of selling sponsorships, the key participants feel there is still a significant amount of money that can be raised, even though only a few members are doing the bulk of the selling. It was suggested by the board that the Rotary Radio Day fund raiser continue as long as an administrative team steps forward to organize the event. Roger Black was the lone dissenting voice. The board decided there should be more discussion with membership about what they need to bring to the table if the club continues with Rotary Radio Days and to put off an up/down vote in the immediate future.

Sunrise Rotary Club of Plattsburgh, NY Inc.

Rockeater Race — A proposal that the Sunrise Rotary Club take over the Rockeater Obstacle Race at the City Beach is being examined. More information is needed but it appears the financial needs will require significant corporate support. Allison H-B expressed a concern that the event may be beyond the capabilities of the club although she could see it being refocused on the city beach location with more water events and events for children. More information will be sought.

ALICE — The board still feels it needs more information on exactly where the money will go if the club donates to the organization and more specifics on how it will help.

Schluter Ball — A discussion with Schluter's people about the club partnering with them on the major event (a ball) is scheduled August 11. A report on the substance of the discussions will be forthcoming.

Outdoor Art Downtown — Completing the outdoor sculpture at the Public Library will take longer than originally expected. The club remains committed to the Outside Art: Plattsburgh Public Art Project.

District Conference — The board approved a motion to pay for one of its members and spouse to attend and stay overnight at the District Conference at the Akwasasne Casino on Sept. 29 and 30, 2017. Motion put forth by Joanne Dahlen, seconded by Allison Hulbert-Bruce.

Community Bank Checking Account — Jessica Sears put forth a motion to switch our checking account to Community Bank on Rte. 3 in Plattsburgh and to update the signatures to this year's officers. The motion was seconded by Joanne Dahlen and passed by the board.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:56 a.m. Motion by Jessica Sears, seconded by Joanne Dahlen.







Alternative to Rotary Radio Days

This concept is designed to appeal to the same businesses who have been supporting Rotary Radio Days but it repackages the format to:

- Drop the radio aspect
- Associate the fund raiser with Community Service in general and specific community service organizations in particular
- Provide business underwriters of the event with positive community visibility
- Provide community service organizations with recognition and community awareness
- Emphasize Sunrise Rotary's philosophy of "Service Above Self"

How it will work:

- We create a Community Service Expo similar to the Business Expo concept.
- Along with holding a public event where Community Service organizations can talk about themselves and provide literature about their services, we also use the event to spotlight a Volunteer of the Year for each organization.

The fund raiser aspect involves selling business sponsorship levels to underwrite a given community service organization's cost for a table at the event.

Our obligation will include:

- Organizing and publicizing the event
- Providing a venue
- Providing a space with a table and chairs for each participating community service organization
- Providing signage for each community service organization
- Providing a directory/map of all community service organizations at the event
- Organizing and hosting the Volunteer Recognition aspect of the event

Obviously there is a huge amount of research which needs to be conducted before we can even decide whether the event is financially viable and worth the effort. If we decide that it is worth doing, it will take a huge effort to organize and arrange. I see this needing about 12-months of planning before the first presentation.

Assists with completion of application, connects Prospect with membership chair or committee member. Assist in tracking Prospect through New Member program (Red to Blue).

Mentor

A Member, Facilitates a Prospect through the process of becoming a New Member. A Mentor can provide orientation and qualify a prospect for New Member/Member status. Assists Sponsor in successful transition From Application through Member status (Red to Blue)

How Do I become a Member

Approach:

- 1. Applicant is presented by a Sponsor
- 2. Applicant inquiring to join the club, Non Sponsored. Request via Email or a visitor/Guest Speaker or Transfer.

Application to be provided by Club Secretary or the designee to Applicant.

Prospect and Sponsor to complete Application and return to Club Secretary or Designee (Membership Chair). Membership committee will review application and vet applicant. This could be done by a member reaching out and or meeting via face to face or a phone call with Prospect. Recommend to Board as to accept or decline Prospect. Upon Board approval Prospect will become New member and confirm Sponsor and Mentor are assigned. Work towards Member Status (Blue Badge)

PROCEDURE TO PROPOSE AND SPONSOR A NEW MEMBER The Rotary Club of Plattsburgh Sunrise procedure for bringing new members into our club:

- 1. Invite a potential new member to attend at least 3 Meetings or events as your guest. Please introduce the person as your "honored guest" and not as a potential new member. At that time you should discuss with the person the benefits and obligations of being a member of the Rotary Club.
- 2. If, after your conversations with the person, you then feel that he/she would be an asset to our club and should be considered for membership, please contact either the Club Secretary or Membership Chair and request that a Rotary Information meeting be scheduled. You will now become the Sponsor. Inform the prospective member that both of you will be invited to attend a Rotary Information Meeting. Both of you will be contacted to arrange a convenient time to meet.
- 3. When notified of the time and place, attend the Rotary Information Meeting with your prospect. Also in attendance will be the Club President and Membership Director or other Membership Committee member. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the qualifications, benefits, expectations and obligations of membership in the club. Both of you will be given an opportunity to ask questions. Your prospect will be given a Membership Packet including Rotary and club information and a membership application. After the meeting, the application can be filled out and signed by both you and the prospect. The completed application is to be given to the Secretary or Membership Director.
- 4. The following procedure will then take place:
- a. The Membership Committee will verify that the application is complete, references will be checked and a Rotary classification will be assigned.
- b. The application will be submitted to the Board of Directors at its next regularly scheduled meeting. You will be notified of its decision.
 - c. If approved, the candidate's name and information will be published in the Bulletin.
- d. If there are no objections from the membership within 10 days of the published date, the candidate will become eligible for induction after payment of the initial fee and prorated membership fee and membership dues.

5. Arrangements will be made for you to Sponsor the new member to a regular meeting where he/she will be inducted into the club as a new member. Until inducted as a new member, the person should continue to attend regular meetings and be introduced as your "honored guest".
6. It is expected that the membership process will take 4-6 weeks. If you have any questions, contact the Membership Chair.

I have not done this, because my understanding of this process is way too limited at this time. I will try to clear up what info we want to provide to Denise with you this morning (if you are present) and I am more than willing to call her.

Finally, I feel we as group need to come together and speak about how the on boarding process has gone in the past and where applications are getting stuck in this process. I have had Denise application for at least two weeks now, and don't want to continue letting applications sit like this. Thank you for time and efforts.



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
