

Sunrise Rotary announces the calendar of events for the July 9th Mayor's Cup Festival

Plattsburgh, New York (June 21, 2022) – The Mayor's Cup Festival will be held on Saturday, July 9, 2022, at Plattsburgh's City Beach, the crown jewel of the Lake City, boasting one of the longest sandy beaches on freshwater in the U.S.

The one-day celebration will kick-off early with kayak rides and a 5K run/walk, and events are scheduled throughout the day for the whole family to enjoy including volleyball, sand sculpting, a cornhole tournament and much more. The band Damaged Goods will be performing live at the beach in the afternoon and Tammy's Lunch Box will be on site to add to the day's festivities.

Several years ago, the Sunrise Rotary Club took charge of re-inventing one of Plattsburgh's most cherished summer traditions and moved the Mayor's Cup Festival from Trinity Square in Plattsburgh to the City Beach. "The Mayor's Cup Festival & Regatta is about giving our community an opportunity to celebrate our Lake City and the majestic Lake Champlain, so hosting the Festival at the City Beach seemed like an obvious choice," said Sunrise Rotarian and Mayor's Cup Festival Chair Sue LeBlanc Durocher. "The response to the new Festival venue from the community, local service organizations and sponsors has been astonishing. Thanks in large part to our sponsor partners, this year we will have even more activities scheduled throughout the day.
