## 1. RULES

1.1 This event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*

## 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 Any sailing vessel may be entered in the Racing, Jib & Main and Multihull divisions provided she satisfies the requirements of that division.

3.3 Entries will be accepted until 5.00 PM on Friday July 7, 2023.

3.4 Boats with a valid LCPHRF rating can register the day of the race

## 4. FEES

4.1 There is no fee to participate

## 5. VENUE

5.1 The racing area includes Lake Champlain and Cumberland Bay

## 6. SCHEDULE

6.1 Race Date: July 8, 2023

6.2 There will be no skippers meeting. Race Committee will use VHF 72 to communicate.

6.4. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the Racing Division is 1040

6.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for Jib & Main Division is 1050

## 7. COURSES AND MARKS

## 8. SCORING

8.1 Boats in the Racing and Jib & Main Divisions will be scored on corrected time method based on their Lake Champlain PHRF rating

8.2 Boats in the Portsmouth Division will be scored on corrected time using the Portsmouth Yardstick system

## 9. RISK STATEMENT

9.1 RRS 3 STATES: The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone. By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include heavy winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in an increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes**
